COMCAST GOTHAM BREAKS FIRST GROUND IN MAMMOTH EFFORT TO BRING HIGH-DEFINITION CABLE, INTERNET, AND TELEPHONE SERVICE TO GOTHAM CITY.

With a ribbon-cutting ceremony that brought out Gotham residents, politicians, and celebrities, COMCAST GOTHAM broke ground on its cutting-edge fiber-optic digital network that will eventually reach every corner of the city.
